DA NANG CITY

The third largest city in Vietnam, Da Nang is in close proximity to Hue- 3 hours North and Hoi An- 30 minutes south, which makes it a perfect stop point for those who need a break from touristy areas. Da Nang is growing into one of the most organized urban area, with attractive beach front villas on the one side and Han River flowing on the other.



Hotel Check in is from 2pm and you may enjoy the rest of your day and evening relaxing in the hotel facilities or venturing out into the City. Rest of the day is leisure time (no car and guide), you can enjoy relaxing in hotel facilities or venturing out into the City.

DAY 2: FULL DAY BANA HILLS

Pick-up and transfer to Bana Hills, take **Cable Car** which gains 5 world scores to Ba Na hills station. Then sightseeing Linh Ung pagoda, The Old Villas of French. Continue moving up by cable car to the Nui Chua Mountain – the top of Ba Na range, visiting Nginh Phong top, Le Nim Villas, Orchid Garden...

You should not miss walking on the **Golden Bridge** amid the foggy hills of the mountain; enjoy the gorgeous view of Da Nang City. Then back to Danang, transferring for dinner before back to hotel.

DAY 3: FULL DAY HOI AN – DANANG

After breakfast at your hotel your lovely guide and driver will meet you in the lobby at 8:00am for your days adventures...

Hoi An is an exceptionally well-preserved example of the most important trading port in Southeast Asia of the period from the 15th until the 19th centuries. Its buildings and street patterns reflect the influences, both local and foreign, that harmoniously combine to produce a unique heritage site



AM – you will visit Cham museum - The Museum's first building was constructed in 1915 and opened to the public in 1919 but many Cham sculptures collected in Da Nang, Quang Nam and elsewhere were brought to the site over the preceding twenty years. With their roots dating back as far as 192 AD, Vietnam's indigenous Cham people lived an Indian way of life in both culture and language. The Cham Museum in Danang is dedicated to this period and the Champa existence which began predominantly in the coastal areas of Vietnam. Housing the

largest exhibition of Cham sculpture in the world, the museum displays almost 300 terracotta and stone works of art ranging from the 7th to the 15th centuries.

Finally, you will go to Han market a significant landmark in Da Nang, having been in operation since the French occupancy in the 1940s. This local market is set within a two-storey building where you can find hundreds of stalls selling an array of local produce, handicrafts, T-shirts, and accessories. It's very much like a miniature version of Ben Thanh Market central market in Ho Chi Minh City, and even if you aren't necessarily looking to buy anything it still offers a fascinating glimpse into local life in Da Nang.

PM -You will walk along the ancient streets to discover the Japanese Bridge: One of the most photographed bridges in Vietnam, Tian Hou Pagoda: a gorgeous 19th-century temple dedicated to the goddess Thien Hau, Tan Ky old house: A well-preserved 18th-century merchant's house, visit some Hoi An handicraft workshops and finally enter the Museum of History-Culture, before returning to Danang city.
