DAY 1: SIEM REAP ARRIVAL

(D)

Welcome to Siem Reap. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by your guide. The guide will assist you to transfer to your hotel for check-in. Please note standard check-in time is at 14:00. Take a rest at hotel till dinner.

Dinner at local restaurant.

Notice: Revealing clothes such as shorts and skirts above the knees and bare shoulders are prohibited in sacred places and temples. On the Buddhist days the Top Tower of Angkor Wat temple is closed.

'Siem Reap is located in northwest Cambodia and is the closest city to the world famous, must see, temples of Angkor. The provincial capital is also called Siem Reap and is located in the South of the province on the shores of the Tonle Sap Lake, the greatest sweet water reserve in whole Southeast Asia. It's a laid-back, lovely place to stay while touring the temples and offers the best of both worlds between observing Cambodian life and enjoying the amenities of modern services and entertainment. Although the Temples are the main 'draw' in this area there is much more to experience by travelling a little further in this region.'

DAY 2: SIEM REAP

(B-L-D)

Breakfast at your hotel. Starting from 8:00am, you will embark on a journey through the history of Angkor. First stop is the **South Gate** (with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk) and see the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** built in the late 12th century. Then onwards to **Bayon temple** which is unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling



faces of Avolokitesvara. Baphuon is like an artificial mountain that recently re-opened after years of restoration. Following, you may visit the Royal Enclosure, **the Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King**. Then continue to the popular temple of **Ta Prohm** which is the modern name of the temple at Angkor, built in the late 12th to early 13th centuries. However, probably more famous for being the location where they filmed the Tomb Raider movie.

Enjoy lunch at local restaurant.

In the afternoon, you will visit the 'main event' the magnificent **Angkor Wat Temple** that is the largest religious monument in the world. Built during the reign of King Suryavarman II in the early 12th century, Angkor Wat was constructed to represent Mount Meru, the Hindu/Buddhist home of the gods. Inside the temple, the walls are covered with stone carvings and bas-reliefs which is quite breathtaking.

Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 3: SIEM REAP

(B-L-D)

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you will visit **Tonle Sap Lake** where you will discover different aspects of the floating village activities: crocodile farming, fish raising, fishing operation preparation, traditional medicine, boat shops, spirit houses, floating schools, etc... Towards, **Artisans D' Angkor**, to discover how wood and stone carvings, lacquering, gilding, and silk paintings are created.



Enjoy lunch at local restaurant.

In the afternoon, visit **Wat Thmei**, one of the memorials of killing field. There are not only the killing field of Choeung Ek near Phnom Penh, also over 18000 killing fields in Cambodia. This one in Siem Reap is a small memorial stupa which contains the skulls and bones of victims killed during the regime of the Khmer Rouge during 1975 – 1979. Next, visit 500 years old **Wat Preah Prom Rath**, a modern-looking temple and monastery located in the heart of Siem Reap. The front gate is the perhaps the oldest looking piece of the site, with Bayon style carvings where the legend tells: There was a Buddhist monk who always traveled by boat to ask for food at Long Vek, the ancient capital of Cambodia, which is situated near the capital city of Phnom Penh. It is a long way from here to the ancient capital. But whenever he returned to this place from Long Vek, the rice in his pot was still fresh and so people nicknamed him Preah Ang Chong Han Hoy, which means "monk with freshly cooked rice in his pot. The boat has been carving as a Buddhist statue and keeps in this pagoda. The last stop of the day is The **Old Market** called Phsar Chas. It is the oldest Khmer market in Siem Reap, where local people sell fresh production goods and household items. You can find the vendors selling inexpensive souvenirs such as clothes, jewelry, and shoes.
